This Oak is no longer available to import from Japan - Sykes Timber imported their stocks in the 1980's. Japanese Oak is a mild and easily worked timber with well defined ray figure on quarter sawn faces. It is stable, durable and stains and finishes well. It is generally slow grown and has a finer texture than other oaks.
