European Cherry | *Prunus avium* |

A beautiful decorative cabinet timber, the heartwood is pale pink to yellow in colour with occasional green streaking and paler yellow sapwood, and delicate graining. Stocked as 52mm boules and 27mm square edged.



European Plum | *Prunus domestica* |

A small tree that only reaches the sawmill occasionally, Plum is slow grown, dense, close grained and comprises a cornucopia of colours. Ideal for small turnery items, boxes etc.



Okan | *Cylicodiscus gabunensis* |

A dense, hard and durable constructional timber from West Africa, Okan is pinkish-red and suitable for structural uses such as jetties, piers, bridges and so on.



Opepe | *Nauclea diderichii* |

A hard and durable West African Timber, from a large tree capable of yielding large cutting sizes. Bright orange when first sawn, Opepe fades to grey with exposure and is used for external construction including decking.



Purpleheart | *Peltogyne spp* |

A timber from a number of species in the Peltogyne genus, Purpleheart is hard and durable but its chief attraction is the intense Purple colour when freshly machined. Fades to dark brown on exposure



Australian Silky Oak | *Cardwellia sublimis* |

Not a true Oak, but related to Eucalyptus, Silky Oak is a deep pink hue with a remarkable lacey figure due to the large rays. Available as thin boards 16mm-22mm thick, good width and lengths.
